All personal identifiable information of those involved in the outbreak should be redacted appropriately, making such data apt for full disclosure and non-exempt from release by your department under the CA Public Records Act.

If there are any fees for searching or copying these records, please inform me if the cost will exceed \$10.00. However, I would also like to request a waiver of all fees in that the disclosure of the requested information is in the public interest and will contribute significantly to the public's understanding of the possible dangers of mandatory vaccination/immunization of the general public, in particular children and persons with depressed immune systems. This information is not being sought for commercial purposes.

The California Public Records Act requires a response within ten business days. If access to the records I am requesting will take longer, please contact me with information about when I might expect such copies. Please provide all materials in electronic format by reply email.

If you deny any part of or this entire request, please cite each specific exemption you feel justifies the refusal to release the information and notify me of the appeal procedures available to me under the law. Thank you for considering my request.
